I know the decimal and percentage equivalent of common fractions.

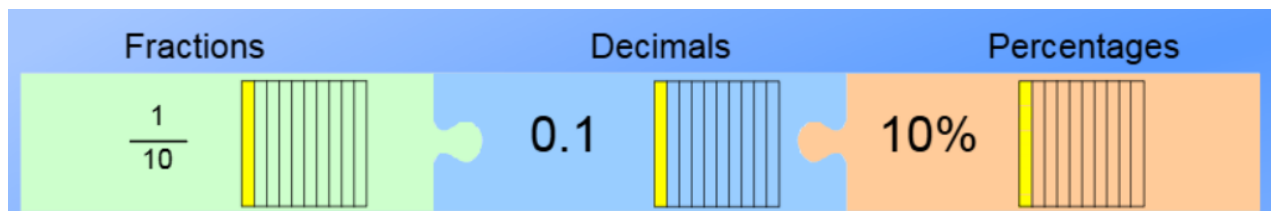
Decimal	Percentage	Fraction

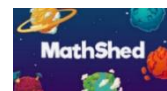
What is $\frac{3}{4}$ as a **percentage**?
