Chop and Change – What can we learn about Tudor life by looking at their portraits?

Listen to some Tudor songs from Horrible Histories. What interesting facts did you learn?	Create an information leaflet about one King Henry VIII's six wives.	Create a puppet of a character from a Shakespeare play.
Make a model of a Tudor house.	What would be served at a Tudor feast?	Write a letter to King Henry VIII persuading him not to chop off your head for a crime you have been found guilty of.
Create a portrait of a Tudor monarch.	Find out facts about the Tudors: What did they wear? Where did they live? What jobs did they have?	How is your life similar and different a Tudor child's life?

The home learning grid gives a variety of creative tasks for the children to choose from, which link to their topic for the term. We suggest that children choose one to complete, however should they wish to complete more, we recommend no more than three. These tasks are optional and should be chosen in addition to, not instead of, the English and Maths key learning tasks.
