EMERGENCY FOOD DELIVERIES

The Government has offered a weekly food parcel service for NHS "High risk" people, others are considered "extremely vulnerable" but may not be eligible for a food parcel.

Those identified as "high risk" will receive a government food parcel direct to their door weekly. Most of these people will have been contacted directly. If they haven't (and they think they should be on the shielded list), please advise them to check with their GP in the first instance.

If they think they should be registered they need to do this with the Government and can register online at https://www.gov.uk/coronavirus-extremely-vulnerable or by phone 0800 0288327.

The government food parcels contain essential food and household items; each box has enough for 1 person for 1 week. These started arriving in the district on 2^{nd} April and will be delivered on Thursdays.

NHS "extremely vulnerable" people will also be prioritised by UK supermarkets for online delivery slots. The government has shared its extremely vulnerable list with supermarkets so they can identify any customers on those lists. These people should receive an email direct from the supermarket.

HELP WITH MEALS, SHOPPING & PRESCRIPTIONS

HOME ESSENTIALS IN A CRISIS

There are emergency vouchers for "home essentials in a crisis" for families (with children) lacking money. Clients must be able to go online and must complete the online application themselves. https://www.kent.gov.uk/social-care-and-health/care-and-support/benefits/home-essentials-in-a-crisis
They should receive £9 per person per household to spend on shopping (not restricted to food).
The online form is straightforward and vouchers will arrive the next day. Full details on the link.

FREE SCHOOL MEAL VOUCHERS

Children eligible for free school meals will receive vouchers allowing them to continue to access meals while schools are closed. Some schools are still providing meals, but where this is not possible, schools can provide every eligible child with a weekly shopping voucher worth £15 to spend at supermarkets (Morrisons, Tesco, Sainsbury's, Asda, Waitrose, M&S). Parents will receive the voucher from their child's school, which can be redeemed online via a code or sent to their house as a gift card.
