Be your best *you*

I understand that the River and Lydden Primary Schools' Acceptable Use Policy will help keep me safe and happy online at home and at school.

- I only go online when an adult is with me.
- I only click on online links and buttons when I know what they do. If I am not sure, I ask an adult first.
- I keep my personal information like my name, age and address safe.
- I keep my passwords safe.
- I only send polite and friendly messages online.
- I know the school can see what I am doing online when I use school laptops and ipads, including if I use them at home.
- I know that when in school I can only use school laptops, computers, and iPads and I will not bring my own devices into school.
- I always tell an adult if something online makes me feel upset, unhappy, or worried.
- If I see anything online that makes me feel unhappy or worried, I will always tell an adult. Or close the screen or turn the iPad face down.
- I can visit www.ceopeducation.co.uk to learn more about keeping safe online.
- I will report any damage or faults with equipment used.
- I know that if I do not follow the school rules, I will have a consequence in line with the behaviour policy, like missing my lunchtime.
- I have read and talked about these rules with my parents/carers.
