

Year 1 Home Learning Grid

Paws, claws and whiskers – Why can't meerkats live at the North Pole?

Create your own animal illustration inspired by Eric Carle.	We are learning to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. Use 2p, 5p and 10p coins to practise your counting.	Make a pizza, cake or sandwich. Cut it into halves and quarters with a grown up.
Create an information leaflet on how to look after a pet.	Go on a tree spotting walk. Collect the leaves you find and use them to identify the trees.	Plant a seed and watch it grow. You might like to keep a diary.
Which animal would you rather be... a meercat or a polar bear? Tell us why.	Create a habitat for a hot or cold place e.g. the North Pole or Sahara Desert.	Make a poster about how to be a good friend.

The home learning grid gives a variety of creative tasks for the children to choose from, which link to their topic for the term. We suggest that children choose one to complete, however should they wish to complete more, we recommend no more than three. These tasks are optional and should be chosen in addition to, not instead of, the English and Maths key learning tasks.
