$5 + 0 = 5$

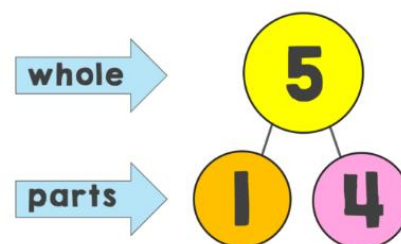

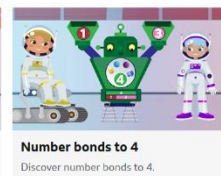
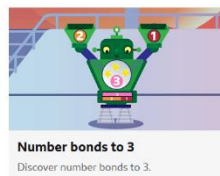
What is 5 **take away** 2?

Use practical resources:
