How united is the United Kingdom?

Research the United Kingdom. Find at least 5 interesting facts.	If you could move to another country, which country would you choose? Why? Research your chosen country.	Draw or paint a picture of what home means to you. What makes it feel like a home?
What could you do to help someone who is new to a community feel welcome? Be creative! You could make a poster, poem, art, game or song.	Do you know someone who has moved from one country to another? Ask them about their life. What did you learn?	Imagine a person has to leave their home unexpectedly and can only take five things in a backpack. What would you pack? Why have you chosen those items?
Imagine a child has just moved to Dover. Give them some advice and top tips. Tell them about your favourite things. • What should they do? • Where should they visit?	Research a famous refugee. For example, Freddie Mercury, Judith Kerr, Rita Ora, Paddington Bear, Superman. • What are they known for? • What have they achieved? • Where were they born? • Why did they leave? • What could we learn from them?	

The home learning grid gives a variety of creative tasks for the children to choose from, which link to their topic for the term. We suggest that children choose one to complete, however should they wish to complete more, we recommend no more than three. These tasks are optional and should be chosen in addition to, not instead of, the English and Maths key learning tasks. Home learning is due in by the last day of term.
